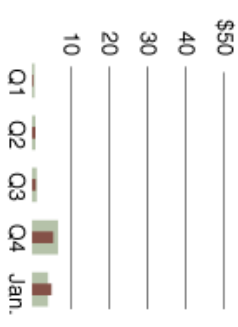

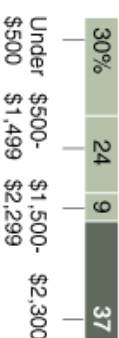

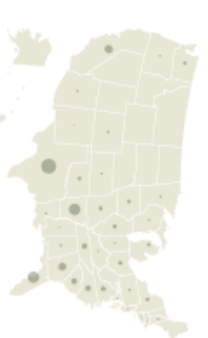
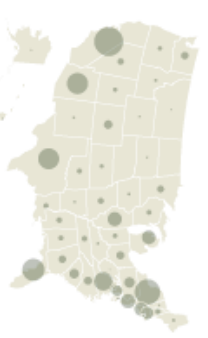
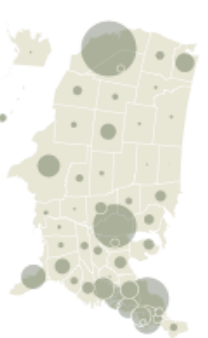
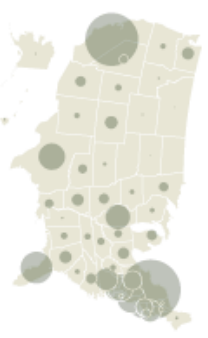
Spending breakdown
