Daily Presidential Tracking Poll

Thursday, September 25, 2008

The Rasmussen Reports daily Presidential Tracking Poll for Thursday shows Barack Obama attracting 49% of the vote while John McCain earns 46%. Other than the bounces related to his convention and speech in Berlin, this is the first time Obama has had 49% support on back-to-back days since early July. It's also McCain's lowest level of support in nearly three weeks.

New polling released this morning shows Obama with a two-point advantage in [North Carolina](#). Data will be released today for [Ohio](#), [Pennsylvania](#), and [West Virginia](#).

Obama is now viewed favorably by 56% of voters, McCain by 55%. [Rasmussen Markets](#) data, which had shown the race to be a toss-up for much of the past week, now shows Obama as the clear favorite and currently gives the Democrat a [56.5](#) chance of victory

The Rasmussen Reports [Balance of Power Calculator](#) shows Obama leading in states with 193 Electoral College votes while McCain has the edge in states with 174 votes. When “leaners” are included, Obama leads 255-247
